Upon completion of the Bachelor of Christian Business Administration, the graduate should be able to:

5. Evaluate personal, spiritual, and professional growth and begin developing habits that support lifelong learning and ethical leadership in Christian business environments.

The program equips students to serve effectively in churches, nonprofit organizations, faith-based enterprises, and the marketplace.
