




Degree Timeline

Below is a breakdown of the timeline it will take for a student to complete their degree. This timeline is contingent upon how many classes a student may take per quarter and if there is a professor available to teach the course. Dates may be tentative to change at the discretion of the Chancellor.



Associate of Biblical & Theological Studies - ABTS

20 classes

60 credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 20 quarters an average of 5 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 10 quarters an average of 2 1/2 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 7 quarters an average of 1 ½ years to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 5 quarters an average of 1 year and 1 quarter to fulfill

Associate of Christian General Studies - ACGS

20 classes

60 credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 20 quarters an average of 5 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 10 quarters an average of 2 1/2 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 7 quarters an average of 1 ½ years to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 5 quarters an average of 1 year and 1 quarter to fulfill

129 credit hours

- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 4 quarters an average of 1 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 3 quarters an average of 9 ½ months to fulfill

Master of Divinity – M. Div.

29 classes

90 Credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 29 quarters an average of 6 years and 3 months to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 15 quarters an average of 3 years and 6 months to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 10 quarters an average of 2 1/2 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 8 quarters an average of 1 year to fulfill

Master of Theology – Th.M.

15 classes

48 Credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 15 quarters an average of 3 years and 9 months to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 8 quarters an average of 2 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 5 quarters an average of 1 year and 3 months to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 4 quarters an average of 1 year to fulfill

Master of Christian Business Administration - MCBA

18 classes

54 Credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 18 quarters an average of 4 ½ years to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 9 quarters an average of 2 years and one quarter to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 6 quarters an average of 1 year and 2 quarters to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 5 quarters an average of 1 year and 1 quarter to fulfill

Doctor of Ministry – D. Min.

11 classes

36 Credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 11 quarters an average of 2 years and 9 months to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 7 quarters an average of 1 1/2 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 4 quarters an average of 1 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 3 quarters an average of 9 ½ months to fulfill

Doctor of Theology – Th.D.

17 classes

48 Credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 17 quarters an average of 4 years and 1 quarter to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 9 quarters an average of 2 years & 1 quarter to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 6 quarters an average of 1 ½ years to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 5 quarters an average of 1 year and 1 quarter to fulfill

Doctor of Christian Counseling – DCC

20 classes

60 Credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 20 quarters an average of 5 years to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 10 quarters an average of 2 years & 2 quarters to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 7 quarters an average of 1 year & 3 quarters to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 5 quarters an average of 1 year & 1 quarter to fulfill

Doctor of Pastoral Counseling – DPC

18 classes

54 Credit hours

- If the student takes 1 course each quarter = 18 quarters an average of 4 years and 2 quarters to fulfill
- If the student takes 2 courses each quarter = 9 quarters an average of 2 years & 1 quarter to fulfill
- If the student takes 3 courses each quarter = 6 quarters an average of 1 ½ years to fulfill
- If the student takes 4 courses each quarter = 5 quarters an average of 1 year and 1 quarter to fulfill

Honorary Doctor of Divinity

A Doctor of Divinity is an earned and an honorary degree. The title is bestowed to individuals who have devoted their lives to theological pursuits or community betterment.
